# Getting Access

Your **child's teacher** will create a My ZB Portal account for you.

Once the teacher has created an account for you, you will receive an **e-mail** that contains an **activation link**.

Click on the **activation link** in the e-mail to finish setting up your account.

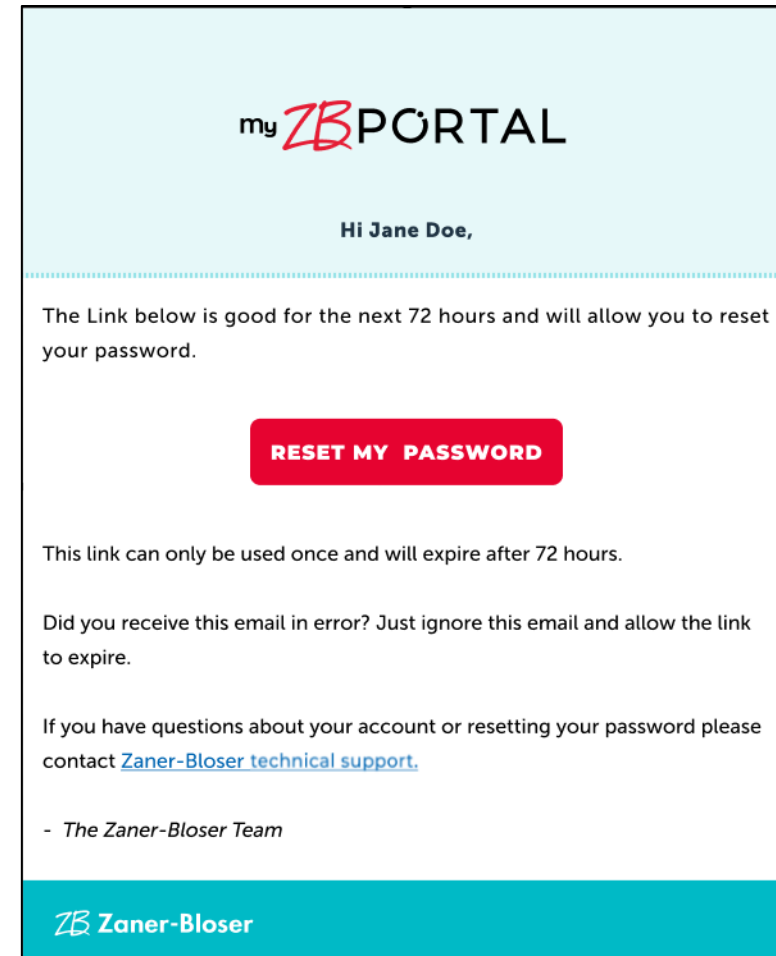
Once you set up your account, **navigate** to [myzbportal.com](https://myzbportal.com) to log in.

# Activating Accounts

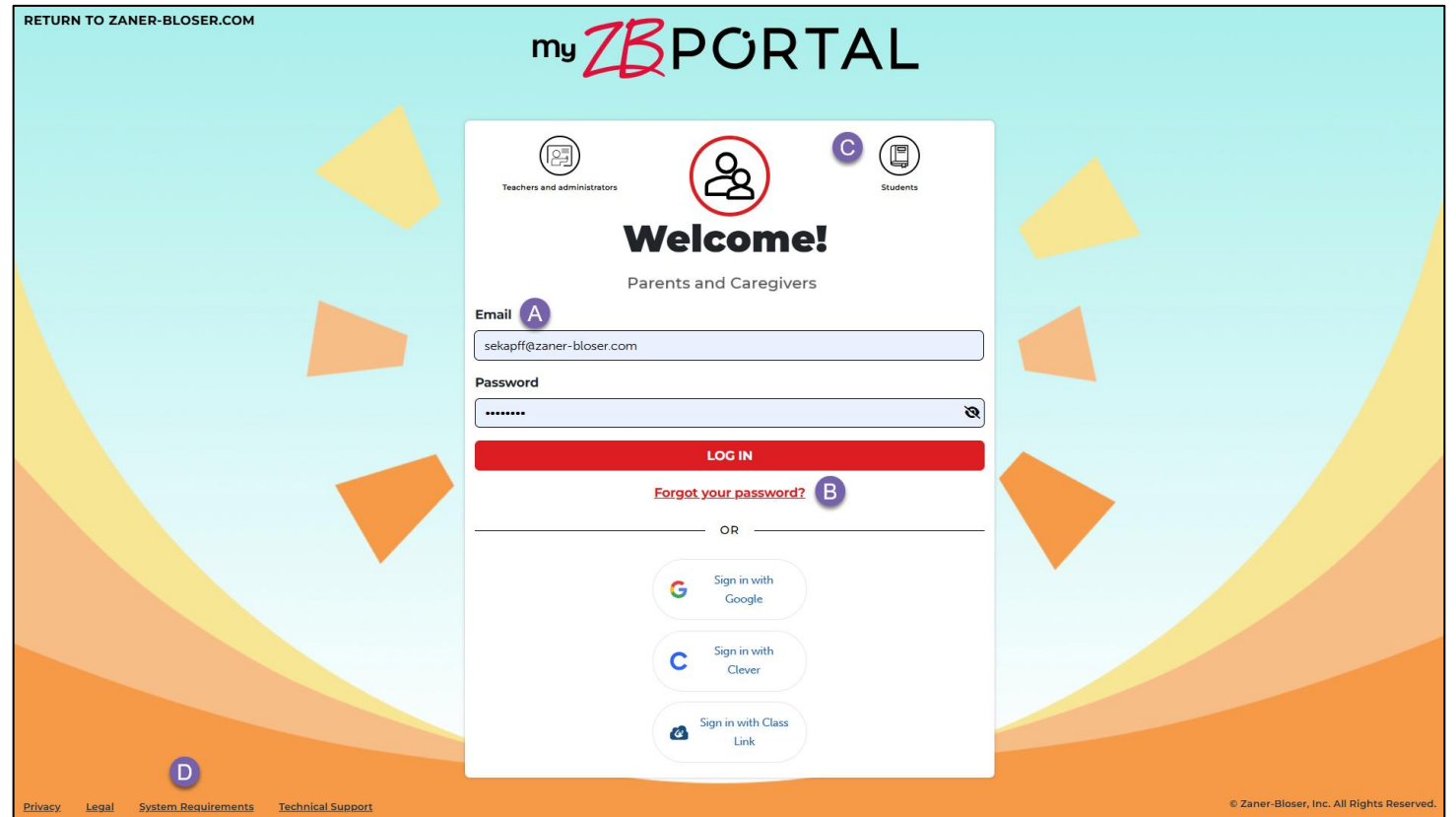
After your child's teacher has created an account for you, you will receive an activation e-mail to your e-mail address.

In the middle of the e-mail is an activation link. Click on the activation link to finish setting up your account.



# Logging In

- A** Once you have set up your account, **log in with your e-mail address and password here.**
- B** Forgot your password? No worries! Click the **Forgot Your Password** link to reset your password.
- C** If your child need to log in, click the **I'm a Student** link to switch to the Student Portal.
- D** These links contain important information about **privacy, legal, and system requirements.**



# Selecting a Language

- A** The first time you log in, you will be asked to select your **preferred language**.
- B** You can change this later by clicking on the **drop-down arrow** next to your e-mail address.
- C** Then click on **Choose Language**.

A

Your Child's name is listed in the upper left-hand corner of the screen. If you have more than one child using Superkids or Zaner-Bloser products, you can toggle between children by clicking on their name and then selecting the other child's name.

You will find your child's **class and the current school year**.

C

The left-hand navigation includes:

- Resources Archive
- ZB Portal for Students

D

This is where you can update your **account information and log out**.

E

The **Help** button is where you can find additional troubleshooting and resources.

The **ZB Portal for Students** page displays helpful login information about how your child can access MyZBPortal.com.

A

Your child's name and school ID is displayed. For security purposes, the child's password is not displayed.

B

Clicking the Log in For Student's Name will allow you to log in for your child, even if your child cannot remember their password.
